WHAT IS THE ABSTINENCE EDUCATION PROGRAM (AEP)?



The AEP is an abstinence until marriage education program specifically designed for adolescents and teenagers between the ages of 10 and 19.

The primary purpose of the AEP is to provide holistic abstinence education to adolescents and teens in a safe, teen friendly, nonjudgmental environment. In addition to abstinence education, the program also provides character education, refusal skills training, and education on setting goals and planning for the future.

WHEN AND WHERE DOES THE ABSTINENCE EDUCATION PROGRAM MEET?

The AEP meets Monday– Friday from 4:00 p.m.–7:00 p.m. at five sites in the Carrollton area. We also conduct one Saturday activity per month with the youth. The sites are listed below:
